

Know Your Rights Card

Print, cut out, and carry this card with you

Carry this card with you. If you are stopped by immigration officers or the police, you can hand it to the officer and remain silent while they read it. Cut along the dashed line to carry the card in your wallet.

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS!

If you are stopped by immigration or the police:

- Hand this card to the officer and remain silent.
- This card explains that you are exercising your right to refuse to answer questions until you have talked with a lawyer.

To: Immigration or Other Officer

Right now I am choosing to exercise my legal rights.

- I will remain silent, and I refuse to answer your questions.
- If I am detained, I have the right to contact an attorney immediately.
- I refuse to sign anything without advice from an attorney.
